Upcoming Event: Twin Rivers
November 11-14, 2010

This is shaping up to be a GREAT event. Plan on driving down on Thursday. It's a 6 1/2-hour drive from Somerset. They have dug trenches & built forts for us to fight in. This is going to be a different type of reenactment, as most battles are not scripted. (For you new guys, this means we don't know who will win.) It could be a running battle all day, not your usual dog-and-pony show of 45 minutes for the public. They have built an authentic town of Dover, for the civilian reenactors to be in. This might give us an opportunity to interact with the civilians in a period-correct time frame. Uniform: Federal- Call me if you need anything.

Tents: Bring your A-Frame, in case of bad weather. We will not be in company streets. We are sleeping in the woods, campaign style. So bring your dog tents to make shebangs. I'll bring the company flies.

Food: Bring your own food to cook. There will be sutlers, but I'm not sure how close they will be. Be sure to bring food you can put in your haversack because we could be in the field all day and you'll need to eat lunch and supper out of it.

Ammo: Bring 160 rounds, expect to burn a lot of powder. I have the new caps in, I will bring powder & caps to sell, but you need to make your rounds before you get there. I will bring the ammo box to store your extra rounds in. Put your name in or on the bag, so we can identify them in the box.

Fees: \$20 pre-paid or as a walk-on.

Other items: It could be cold at night, so at this event, I will allow you to bring a sleeping bag. Just make sure that it is covered up with a period-correct blanket. You will be able to drive up to the camp to unload on Thursday. The event is being held at the Gibson Reed Ranch, 8115 US 72, Michigan City, MS, 38647. This is halfway between Corinth, MS & Memphis, TN.
